8:30a.m. Please meet TOMOMI SHIMABUKURO, your bilingual tour escort/ guide at the JAPAN AIRLINES check-in area located in Lobby #5 of the DANIEL K INOUE HONOLULU INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT. She will give you your packet with JAL “E – ticket” and luggage tags prior to check-in. Due to tight airport security, you will be checking in individually or as a family.

3:50p.m. Arrival at Osaka Kansai International Airport. **Visit Japan Web (recommended)** is a web service that people entering to Japan and Japanese returning back to Japan have to use for Quarantine, Immigration and Customs procedures in order to enter/return to Japan. After immigration, you need to go to the “electronic Japan Custom machine” to scan your passport and your QR Code. After customs, please take the elevator to the 2nd Floor of the JAL Domestic counter to check-in which is located on the right-hand side. After check-in for your Okinawa flight is done, you will have some time to eat dinner or snack.

7:30p.m. **Please go thru Security to get to your departure gate. Drinks are allowed, please show your drinks to the security agent, they have a liquid analyzer machine.**

8:05p.m. Depart on Japan Trans Ocean Flt.#09 bound for Okinawa.

No meals will be served on this domestic flight.

10:15p.m. Arrive NAHA, OKINAWA at NAHA DOMESTIC AIRPORT. Please pickup your own luggage(s) from the carousel in the baggage claim area. For your convenience, please use the baggage cart for your luggage. We will proceed to our awaiting chartered motorcoach to transfer to HOTEL PALM ROYAL NAHA (newly renovated rooms) for 8 nights stay. The hotel is located near Kokusai Dori and near the entrance of famous HEIWA DORI. DON QUIJOTE KOKUSAI DORI is opened from 9:00am – 5:00am. The hotel is less than 15 minutes away from the Monorail, Yui Rail – Makishi Station. Coin laundry facility, ice machine, and microwave on the 2nd floor. Public bath(onsen style) also located on the 2nd floor for men & women separate.

Today is NAHA TSUNAHIKI FESTIVAL (Tug of War) an annual event held in Naha.

In the morning (11:30am–2pm), Kokusai Dori hosts a parade, with karate demonstrations, drums, and firecrackers. In the afternoon, the action moves to Route 58 (2:30pm–5pm). The flags from the parade are lined up. People dressed like Ryukyu kings face each other, wielding naginata swords from atop each section of the rope. Then the two ropes are connected, and the challenge begins.

Each team tries to pull the rope their way for 30 minutes, or until the rope is moved by a pre-defined distance. It does not matter which side wins, everyone is welcome to celebrate.

With completion set for Fall of 2026, national and Okinawan authorities are working together to restore intricate details such as the traditional roof tiling and interior ornamentation.

11:00a.m.

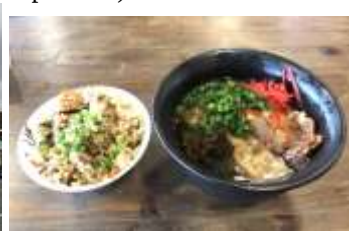

Research has identified certain components that give Nuchi-masu its distinct flavor, praised by famous chefs at many premier restaurants in Japan. On the 2nd floor of the factory is Café’ with very good Nuchimasu Salt Soft Ice Cream(no sugar added), Azuki Beans with Soft Ice Cream in a cup, and Umi Sora Salt Soft Ice Cream in Waffle Cone.

On the third floor of the facility is a specially designed observation area where visitors can enjoy a spectacular ocean view of Manzamo.

KIN TOWN is well known because of KYUZO TOYAMA, the father of Okinawan immigration. Kyuzo Toyama led the first group of Okinawans to Hawaii in 1899. Toyama and 25 other men arrived on January 8, 1900 to work on the plantations. He later returned to Okinawa and led a second group of 40 people to Hawaii in 1903. He worked on the plantation and studied English. He gave lectures to encourage Okinawan workers. Kyuzo Toyama died in 1910 and a statue of him was erected in Kin Town in 1961.



Today is KIN TOWN FESTIVAL, after visiting the Toyama Kyuzo Statue, we will make a stop at KIN DISTRICT PARK, where KIN TOWN FESTIVAL is held for the weekend.
