5:35p.m. Arrive SYDNEY, AUSTRALIA. Upon arrival, immigration and customs procedures are required.

Monday, Mar 16 Sydney – Blue Mountain National Park

9:00a.m. A day trip to WORLD HERITAGE'S BLUE MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK., Home of the Three Sisters. Blue Mountain is one of the most spectacular wilderness parks in Australia. It is also the most popular attractions in Australia. The Scenic Railway experience descends 310 meters through a cliff-side tunnel, emerging into ancient rainforest at the Jamison Valley floor. Operating since 1945, the Scenic Railway has thrilled 25 million passengers – this is the fifth generation train to ride the tracks since the Hammon Family opened the attraction.

A free day for you to explore Sydney at your pace.

Or be Adventurous and try the Sydney Bridge Climb, climb to the top of the largest steel arch bridge in the world. At the summit of the iconic Sydney Harbor Bridge, you'll relish breathtaking views of Australia's most beautiful city and beyond.

The Bridge Climb is on Cumberland Street in the historic Rocks, a stroll from either Circular Quay or Wynyard Train Station. Climbs begin at regular intervals, from early in the morning through to the evening, and all the equipment you'll need is provided.

Your climb leader is there to make sure your experience safe and fun, and will provide intriguing facts about the bridge along the way. After the climb you'll receive a photo of yourself on the bridge, so you can cherish the memory and share your adventure with family and friends back home.

A range of climbs is available. The main Bridge Climb is 3h 30min return along ladders and catwalks and the outer arch of the bridge to the top, which is 134 meters above the sparkling blue waters of Sydney Harbor. **Cost: AUD \$303 per person**

No Visa is required to enter New Zealand, however New Zealand requires your passport not to expire within 3 months from the return date to the United States to enter their country.
