Nov 24th, Monday HONOLULU – FUKUOKA via Tokyo/ Haneda

- 9:00a.m. Please meet your local bilingual tour escort, TOMOMI SHIMABUKURO, your tour escort at the Japan Airlines check-in area at HONOLULU INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, Lobby #5. She will give you your packet with your JAL "E Ticket Receipt" and luggage tags prior to check-in. Due to tight airport security, you will be checking in individually or as a family. **Please have your passport ready.**
After check-in, you may want to head straight to the TSA line.
- 11:55a.m. Depart Honolulu on Japan Airlines Flt.#073 bound for TOKYO/ HANEDA.
A meal will be served one hour after take-off.

Nov 25th, Tuesday TOKYO/ HANEDA - FUKUOKA

- 3:55p.m. Arrival into Tokyo Haneda International Airport. **Visit Japan Web (recommended) is a web service that people entering to Japan even Japanese citizens returning back to Japan will use this for Immigration and Customs procedures in order to enter/return to Japan.**
After immigration, you need to go to the "electronic Japan Custom machine" to scan your passport and your QR Code.
For your convenience, please use the baggage cart for your luggage.
Please pickup your own baggage from the carousel and go thru the electronic custom line.
After exit, please turn to your right to the far end of the building. There's an "Interline Check-in Counter" for Japan Airlines to check your luggage for our next domestic flight to Fukuoka Airport.
After we are done checking our luggage at JAL Interline Counter, will take an elevator to the ground floor, to take the INTER-TERMINAL free shuttle bus to take the shuttle to DOMESTIC TERMINAL #1.
Upon arrival at domestic terminal #1, we need to take the escalator to the 2nd floor (Departure Lobby).
7:15p.m. Depart Tokyo/ Haneda on Japan Airlines Flt.#333 bound for FUKUOKA DOMESTIC AIRPORT.
9:20p.m. Arrive FUKUOKA DOMESTIC AIRPORT.
Please pickup your own luggage(s) from the carousel in the baggage claim area.
For your convenience, please use the baggage cart for your luggage.
At the arrival lobby, you will be met by your English speaking tour guide from Tokyo, Ms. Yuuki Kobayashi.
We will walk over to our chartered bus.
We will be staying 3 nights at HOTEL NIKKO FUKUOKA, walking distance to Hakata JR Station also known as JR Hakata City. Within the Hakata Station, there is a supermarket, Tokyu Hands, and plenty of places to eat. Next to Hakata Station is the Hakata Bus Terminal which has 100 Yen Daiso, 300 Yen Shop, and plenty of places to eat.

Nov 26th, Wednesday FUKUOKA

- 9:00a.m. Breakfast at the hotel.
1-day sightseeing tour of FUKUOKA CITY.
First stop, KUSHIDA SHRINE built in 757AD, destroyed by fire in battle. The present shrine was rebuilt as part of Toyotomi Hideyoshi's reconstruction of Hakata in 1587.
HAKATA MACHIYA FOLK MUSEUM, the life and culture of Hakata mainly of the Meiji & Taisho eras are introduced. They also have a souvenir shop that sells traditional crafts items and Hakata dolls.
- 12:00p.m. For lunch and some shopping time, YOUME TOWN HAKATA, local shopping mall with Uniqlo, GU,

UMAYA Restaurant that serves tempura, soba, tendon, katsudon, and gyutan (beef tongue).

GYUMARU Restaurant that serves hamburger steak with their special deramisse sauce.

KINEYA Restaurant that serves different udon and soba.

SUPERMARKET, 100 Yen DAISO and 3 COINS (300 Yen store) also inside YOUME TOWN.

After lunch, FUKUOKA TOWER, Fukuoka's landmark, the 234m (over 760 ft) high tower is covered with 8000 half mirrors and is the tallest seaside tower in Japan. You will be able to see the urban functions, nature and culture of Fukuoka city all at once from the observation room at over 400 ft high.

Second stop, FUKUOKA CITY MUSEUM, it introduces the history and the life of people in Fukuoka, which has developed as a hub of international exchanges in the Asian Region since ancient times. Permanently exhibits the gold seal, the national treasure, and the famous spear, which is sung in the famous local folk song, "Kurodabushi".

The Gold seal replica is one of the popular museum items for souvenir.



4:00p.m.

Return to hotel. The rest of the day is at your leisure. (B)

Nov 27th, Thursday FUKUOKA

Breakfast at the hotel.

9:00a.m.

Depart for YANAGAWA, a small town southwest of Fukuoka Prefecture. It's about 1 hour away from Hakata City. Yanagawa is famous for its canals and river eel (unagi).

Upon arrival at Yanagawa, enjoy the relaxing time on DONKOBUNE (donko boat ride) along the 2.4 mile canals. It is Yanagawa City's main tourist attraction.



Lunch at the local specialty UNAGI no SEIRO MUSHI— steamed unagi (eel) rice. The grilled eel, sauce, and some finely shredded fried eggs are placed on top of semi-cooked rice in a bamboo box.

Then everything gets steamed until the rice is fully cooked. You can only eat it in Yanagawa.

DAIZAIFU TENMANGU SHRINE, dedicated to Michizane Sugawara called "god of learning". Among the hundreds of Tenmangu Shrines throughout Japan, Daizaifu is the most important one alongside Kyoto's Kitano Tenmangu. While visiting Daizaifu, you have to try their famous "UMEGAEMOCHI".

Although this item contains the word "ume", there isn't umeboshi (pickled plum) in it. It is quite a simple dessert, with azuki (red bean paste) inside the mochi. The crispy outer layer of mochi combined with the chewy filling makes it an irresistible dessert.

5:00p.m.

Return back to Hakata City. The rest of the day at your leisure. (B, L)

****Please have an overnighter bag ready for 11/28 (1 night), your 1 piece luggage will be sent to Kagoshima to arrive on 11/29 via Takkyubin****

Nov 28th, Friday FUKUOKA – KAGOSHIMA

Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out of the hotel.

Walk over to JR HAKATA STATION.

9:29a.m.

Depart on KYUSHU SHINKANSEN " SAKURA #543" bound for KAGOSHIMA.

10:55a.m.

Arrive at JR KAGOSHIMA CHUO STATION, You will have some free time for lunch before our sightseeing of Kagoshima City. Kagoshima specialty products are kuro buta, kuro gyu, and kuro su (black pork, black beef, and black vinegar).

AMU PLAZA SHOPPING MALL connected to Kagoshima Chuo Station has some good restaurants for lunch and dinner.

B1 Floor, TONKATSU KATSUJU serves Kagoshima Kuro Buta Filet Katsu Teishoku (1900Yen).

B1 Floor, KAITEN SUSHI MADOKA serves daily lunch special from Monday-Friday, from 11:30am-3pm.

B1 Floor, ZABON RAMEN (listed as #4 Top Ramen in Kagoshima) and RAMEN KOMURASAKI #5, been in business since 1950.

After lunch, drive thru the city of KAGOSHIMA CITY passing the STATUE of SAIGO TAKAMORI.

A stop at SENGAN EN (also known as ISO TEIEN) is a Japanese style landscape garden along the

northern coast of Kagoshima. Constructed in 1658 by the wealthy Shimazu Clan, one of the most powerful feudal clans during the Edo Period (1603-1867). In July, 2015 Sengan-en and Shoko Shuseikan were recognized as World Cultural Heritage Sites related to Japan's Meiji Industrial Revolution.

- 4:00p.m. Check in at KAGOSHIMA SUN ROYAL HOTEL for 3 nights stay. You can enjoy the best view of Mt. Sakurajima from the hotel and on the 13th floor, onsen (hot springs) overlooking Kagoshima Bay. Onsen facility opens from 6am-10am and 3pm-midnight.
- 6:00p.m. Dinner at the hotel. (B, D)

Nov 29th, Saturday

KAGOSHIMA – SAKURAJIMA – KAGOSHIMA

- 6:30- 8:45a.m. Breakfast at the hotel.

- 9:00a.m. Today half day sightseeing around SAKURAJIMA.

SAKURAJIMA is one of Japan's most active volcanoes and the symbol of Kagoshima.

We will catch a ferry (15-minute ride) to Sakurajima, upon arrival, our first stop is the SAKURAJIMA VISITOR CENTER. The Visitor Center is a place, where we can learn more about the volcanic eruptions and the growth. There's a short video about the active volcano.

We will then go to the observatory with a view of the summit, midway up the mountain, you can feel the power of the active volcano spewing smoke up close.

Before going on the ferry, we will make a stop at MICHINO EKI "SAKURAJIMA", last stop for you to buy anything from Sakurajima area. Sakurajima is known for its Daikon Tsukemono, the world's largest daikon (radishes). They have samples for you to try and the tsukemono prices are cheaper than other places.

Lunch at local restaurant.



- 3:00p.m. After the tour, return back to KAGOSHIMA SUN ROYAL HOTEL.

The rest of the day is at your leisure. There's a courtesy hotel shuttle leaving every 50-60 minutes to JR Kagoshima Chuo Station and TENMOKAN SHOPPING ARCADE, known as the biggest and most thriving shopping street in Kagoshima, with many souvenir shops where you can buy all kinds of local specialties, cakes, and confectionaries of Kagoshima including 100 Yen DAISO Store.

Tenmonkan Street is partly covered by a roof, making it convenient for customers to enjoy shopping without an umbrella on rainy days. (B, L)

Nov 30th, Sunday

KAGOSHIMA – CHIRAN - IBUSUKI – KAGOSHIMA

- 6:30- 8:15a.m. Breakfast at the hotel.

- 8:30a.m. Today we will go to CHIRAN and IBUSUKI.

CHIRAN a small town in the middle of the Satsuma Peninsula in Kagoshima.

Chiran is a preserved samurai district with houses and gardens that date back about 250 years.



CHIRAN PEACE MUSEUM for KAMIKAZE PILOTS which displays about 4,000 photos, final letters, and articles left behind by kamikaze pilots. The museum exhibit on kamikaze pilots are the most extensive of any museum in Japan.

After Chiran, continue on to IBUSUKI (about 1 hour) located on the southern part of the Satsuma Peninsula in Kagoshima. Ibusuki is famous for hot springs and its seaside volcanic sand baths.

Lunch at TOSENKYO NAGASHI SOMEN (Noodle), one of Kagoshima's most famous summer meal

and Ibusuki is well known for this dish. The great thing about this place is it's not just for summer only, you can have it all year round. Ibusuki is also the birthplace of nagashi somen (flowing thin white Japanese noodles made of wheat flour which are usually served cold), a style of eating somen, in which you catch fine white somen noodles from cold running water.

After lunch, experience sand baths along the coast of Ibusuki made by utilizing steam, while lying on the beach, your body gradually gets warm because of the steam. Not only is it the only natural sand bath in the world, the sand is infused with plenty of hot spring water that comes naturally from the beach. Sand Bath Hot Spring has become more popular amongst young ladies as a beauty treatment of the whole body. Tourists from around the world come to experience the steaming hot sand bath.

After the tour return back to Kagoshima.

5:00p.m.

Arrive back to KAGOSHIMA SUN ROYAL HOTEL. Free leisure time.

Dinner is on your own, after dinner, you can relax to go to the onsen. (B , L)

Dec 1st, Monday

KAGOSHIMA – KUMAMOTO

6:30- 8:30a.m.

Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out of the hotel.

9:00a.m.

Bus departs for KUMAMOTO (takes about 3 ½ hours). Kumamoto is located in the southwestern part of Kyushu. On our way to Kumamoto, we will make couple stops for 5-4-4 and lunch break.

For lunch, a stop at MIYAHARA SERVICE AREA. This service area has a food court, bakery, and a restaurant.

After lunch, continue on to Kumamoto.

SUIZENJI PARK, considered to be one of the most beautiful Japanese garden in Japan, built by the Hosakawa Family in the 17th century.

4:30p.m.

Arrive at HOTEL NIKKO KUMAMOTO for 2 nights stay. After check-in, the rest of the day is at your leisure. Hotel is located along Kumamoto's famous shopping arcade. (B)

Dec 2nd, Tuesday

KUMAMOTO

6:30- 8:30a.m.

Breakfast at the hotel.

9:00a.m.

Today we will tour KUMAMOTO CITY. Kumamoto is a city of water with abundant underground water. Kumamoto City is the third biggest city in Kyushu.



SAKURA NO BABA JOSAIEN, is a popular tourist attraction designed to enhance the appeal of the old castle town and convey to visitors the food, history and cultural traditions of the region from Kumamoto Castle, a symbol of the city of Kumamoto.

KUMAMOTO CASTLE MUSEUM “WAKUWAKUZA” offers visitors a glimpse at the 300-year history and culture of the region once known as Higo. This virtual representation allows visitors to go back in time and to see, hear and touch the area's history through the “Tale of Kumamoto Then and Now” exhibit, and to try on traditional Edo-period kimono.

SAKURA NO KOJI, 23 famous shops selling specialty items unique to Kumamoto. Restaurants offer an opportunity to enjoy Kumamoto's distinctive food culture, and many shops sell Kumamoto souvenirs as well as items found only at Josaien.

Lunch at your own expense. Buffet Restaurant “Ginan” (1900Yen per person for 90 minutes),

HIGO MESHIYA “YUMEAGARI” serving KUMAMOTO JO RAMEN, TANTANMEN, BASASHIDON TEISHOKU (Horse Meat Donburi), ASOBI TORIDON(Teriyaki Chicken Donburi) & etc.

RESTAURANT KAIMARU serving TENDON(Shrimp Donburi), MIXED TEMPURA, ROAST BEEF DONBURI, CHICKEN DONBURI, FRESH SALMON SASHIMI DONBURI, & KAJIKI MAGURO DON.

After lunch, last stop, KUMAMOTO CASTLE, the premier landmark of Kumamoto City.

Kumamoto Castle suffered serious damage in the earthquake on April 14, 2016.

The restoration of the main tower was completed in 2019. The top floor of the tower offers a view of the entire park, where reconstruction work is continuing, as well as the landscape of Kumamoto.

An elevator has also been newly installed.

4:00p.m.

Return back to HOTEL NIKKO KUMAMOTO. The rest of the day is at your leisure. (B)

Dec 3rd, Wednesday

KUMAMOTO – BEPPU via Takachiho

6:30- 8:00a.m.

Breakfast at the hotel and check-out of the hotel.

8:30a.m.

Bus departs for BEPPU with a stop at TAKACHIHO GORGE.

11:30-12:30p.m.

Lunch on your own at MICHINO EKI TAKACHIHO.

After the tour, bus will depart for BEPPU.

9:30-10:00a.m. UMI JIGOKU (Sea Hell) is one of the hot springs (onsen) included in Beppu Japan's "[Jigoku Meguri](#)" (Hell Tour), in which you can enjoy famous Japanese hot spring spots all at once. Contrary to name 'hell' by which the tour is called, the cobalt blue color gives the water a very beautiful and dazzling appearance.

10:15-10:45a.m. CHINOIKE JIGOKU (Blood Pond Hell) striking red due to its high iron content, creating blood like appearance.
11:00-11:30a.m. SHIRAIKE JIGOKU (White Pond Hell) milky white, it is famous for being a habitat for tropical fish as it providing hot spring heat in a heart-shaped pond and the pond is surrounded by a circular garden.
11:45-12:15p.m. KAMADO JIGOKU (Cooking Pot Hell) was named after an ancient myth in which steamed rice was cooked with the fumarolic gas discharged at 98 Degrees Celsius (208 Degrees Fahrenheit) as an offering to the Ujigami (guardian god) for the Kamado Hachimangu Shrine Festival.
12:30-2:30p.m. Lunch on your own and some shopping time at YOU ME TOWN BEPPU.
1st Floor: DAISO 100 YEN SHOP, TONKATSU RESTAURANT "YOMETON", ITALIAN TOMATO, KAMAMESHI & UDON, TULLY'S COFFEE for hot dog & other sandwiches, SUSHI MEIJIN has sushi donburi, nigiri set, assorted udon & ramen (small size), and assorted desserts.
3rd Floor: FOOD COURT: SUBWAY (Sandwich), MCDONALD, RINGER HUT (Nagasaki Chanpon) and Saradon Udon(Crispy Noodle with Seafood & Vegetables), HANAMARU UDON, and MR. DONUT
