Monday, Jun 2nd Honolulu – Tokyo/ Haneda

- 9:45a.m. Please meet NADINE SHIMABUKURO at the JAPAN AIRLINES check-in area located at Lobby #5 of the Honolulu International Airport. She will give you your “E – ticket” & luggage tags. Due to tight airport security, you will be checking in individually or as a family.
- 12:45p.m. Depart on Japan Airlines Flt.#73 bound for TOKYO/ HANEDA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT in Japan.

Prior to arrival: Cold Cut Sandwich with pineapple sherbet

- 5:30p.m. Depart on a chartered bus to GRAND NIKKO TOKYO DAIBA HOTEL (5 stars hotel).
- 6:30p.m. Check-in at HOTEL GRAND NIKKO TOKYO DAIBA for 2 nights in Odaiba.
This hotel is located in Odaiba (an artificial island in Tokyo Bay) overlooking the Rainbow Bridge and across from Aqua City (shopping mall).

Mega Pokemon Center and Pikachu Sweets by Pokemon Café located on 2nd floor of Sunshine City ALPA. The largest “Gashapon Store” in the world with over 3000 capsules toys owned by Bandai- Namco Co. located in Sunshine City Mall on the 3rd floor of the World Import Mart Building. A stop at AEON MALL KUSHIRO SHOWA to buy fruits, snacks, drinks, & etc. DAISO on the 1st Floor.

5:00p.m.

Check-in at ANA CROWNE PLAZA HOTEL KUSHIRO for 2 nights stay.

5:30-7:00p.m.

Walk to KUSHIRO FISHERMAN’S WHARF ‘MOO’, dinner on your own. It’s a waterfront complex featuring local delicacies served out of “YATAI FOOD STALLS” on the 2nd Floor. (B)

Friday, Jun 6th Kushiro – Lake Akan – Kushiro

6:30-8:00a.m.

Buffet breakfast on the 18th Floor of the hotel.

8:30a.m.

Bus departs for LAKE AKAN is a beautiful crater lake in AKAN NATIONAL PARK.

Takes 2.5 hours with 5-4-4 Break.

11:00-2:00p.m.

Visit the AKANKO AINU KOTAN is one of the largest Ainu Kotan (settlements) in Hokkaido, inhabited by about 120 people. It is a place where Ainu culture is shared through the experience of interacting, making, eating, inheriting, unleashing and living with nature, based on the Ainu belief that souls reside in all things. Here you can experience the culture and history of the Ainu, who live in harmony with Hokkaido’s magnificent nature. Indoor theater, you can watch Ainu ancient ceremonial dance.

Return back to ANA CROWNE PLAZA HOTEL KUSHIRO. The rest of the evening at your leisure. (B)

Saturday, June 7th Kushiro – Lake Mashu – Abashiri – Monbetsu

6:30-7:30a.m.

Buffet breakfast on the 18th Floor of the hotel.

7:45a.m.

Check-out of the hotel.

8:00a.m.

Bus departs for MONBETSU with couple stops along the way.

9:30-11:00a.m.

First stop, OBSERVATORY DECK to see LAKE MASHU from the top of the hill. LAKE MASHU is considered to be one of the most beautiful lakes in Japan. It is also said to have the purest water in Japan. ASHIYU (Foot Onsen) at MICHINO EKI MASHU ONSEN.

ABASHIRI PRISON MUSEUM, Japan’s only prison museum that show what life was in the notorious jail. Today for lunch, we will have the prisoner’s meal, a real taste of Japan’s prison life.

5:30p.m. Check in at MONBETSU PRINCE HOTEL for 2 nights stay, it's an onsen hotel with western style rooms.

 10:30-12:00p.m. First stop, a visit to OKHOTSK TOWER and RYUHO MUSEUM, great place to view real drift ice even in summer. The museum offers stunning 360-degree panoramic views of the Sea of Okhotsk, the Shiretoko Peninsula, and the Shiretoko Mountain Range from its third-floor observation terrace. There's even the Drift Ice Experience Terrace, set at a chilling -15°C where you can find real drift ice available to touch and full-on recreations low-latitude auroras.



MONBETSU KANI no TSUME, "CRAB CLAW" STATUE is an iconic emblem of Monbetsu.

 12:00-1:15p.m. CAPE SOYA, situated in Wakkanai. It is the northern most point of the island of Hokkaido & by extension the whole Japan.
 CAPE NOSAPPU is located where the waters from the Pacific Ocean meet those from the Sea of Okhotsk. The Cape Nosappu Lighthouse is the oldest in Hokkaido, built in 1872.

5:15p.m. Arrive at SURFEEL HOTEL WAKKANAI for 1 night stay.
 6:00p.m. Buffet dinner at the hotel. **(B, D)**

Tuesday, June 10th**Wakkanai – Rebun Island**

6:30 – 9:00a.m.

Breakfast at the hotel.

9:30a.m.

Check-out of the hotel.

9:45a.m.

Bus departs for WAKKANAI PORT, to take a ferry (2 hours ride) to REBUN ISLAND. Our chartered bus will also go with us on the ferry to REBUN ISLAND.

REBUN ISLAND is an island in the Sea of Japan off the northwestern tip of Hokkaido.



Upon arrival at KAFUKA PORT, lunch on your own at Take-chan Sushi on the 2nd floor of the ferry terminal. Take –chan Sushi has fresh seafood bowls & assorted sushi, ramen, udon, tempura, curry rice, & etc.

After lunch, CAPE SUKAI, from this cape in the northwest part of the island you can see the clear blue sea.

Drive around the Rebun Island to see flowers blooming.

4:45p.m.

Check-in at MITSUI KANKO HOTEL REBUN for 1 night stay, western style rooms.

Natural onsen in the hotel property.

6:00p.m.

Japanese Set Dinner at the hotel. **(B, D)**

Wednesday, Jun 11th**Rebun Island – Rishiri Island**

7:00 – 9:00a.m.

Breakfast at the hotel.

9:15a.m.

Check-out of the hotel.

9:30a.m.

Bus departs for KAFUKA PORT, take a ferry to RISHIRI ISLAND.

10:25a.m.

Board the ferry from KAFUKA PORT to OSHIDOMARI PORT in RISHIRI ISLAND.

11:10a.m.

Arrive at OSHIDOMARI PORT.

11:15-12:15p.m.

Lunch at local restaurant included.

12:30p.m.

After lunch, NOZUKA OBSERVATION DECK, you can see the coastline from the Observation Deck on the left hand sea side of the road. There is a monument to Ronald MacDonald who was the first English teacher in Japan and who had a connection with Rishiri Island.

SHIROI KOIBITO no OKA is a new tourist attraction on Rishiri Island, created with the cooperation of a confectionary manufacturer. It is a quiet observatory where you can see RISHIRI FUJI, OTATOMARI SWAMP, and the mainland of Hokkaido across the Sea of Japan. Shiroi Koibito no Oka" is a nickname for the hill, and the official name is "NUMAURA OBSERVATORY". It is actually the view of Rishiri Fuji from here that appears on the package of "Shiroi Koibito," Hokkaido's famous sweet.

Check in at ISLAND INN RISHIRI for one night stay, western style room with onsen on the hotel property.

6:00p.m.

Buffet dinner at the hotel. **(B, L, D)**

Thursday, Jun 12th**Rishiri Island – Wakkanai – Asahikawa**

7:00-7:45a.m.

Buffet breakfast at the hotel located on the 1st floor.

7:50a.m.

Check-out of the hotel.

8:00a.m.

Bus departs for OSHIDOMARI PORT.

8:25a.m.

Ferry departs from OSHIDOMARI PORT to WAKKANAI PORT.

10:05a.m.

Arrive WAKKANAI PORT.

11:30a.m.

Lunch on our own at MICHI no EKI “NAKAGAWA”. The restaurant has ramen, soba, udon, curry rice, teriyaki pork or beef sukiyaki donburi, katsudon, & etc.
