A visit to MATSUMOTO CASTLE is one of five castles designated as ‘National Treasures of Japan’ and the oldest five-tiered, six-story castle tower remaining in Japan

1:00-2:30p.m.

Arrive at TOBIRA ONSEN – MYOJINKAN (4 star MICHELIN GUIDE HOTEL) for 1 night stay.

The hotel is nestled within a deep valley and surrounded by the mountains of the Yatsugatake National Park. The narrow, winding road to Myojinkan passing rice paddies, vegetable fields, and gives way to the verdant tree covered mountains of one of Japan's most beautiful protected forests.

The rest of the day is at your leisure until dinnertime or enjoy onsen before dinner.

The main attraction of the Tateyama Kurobe Alpine Route is the magnificent scenery of the Tateyama Mountain Range, part of the Chubu Sangaku National Park.

Take a cable car from Tateyama to go up to the Bijodaira and transfer to Tateyama Highland

Bus via scenic Midagahara to Murodo, the highest point 2450 meters (slightly over 8038 ft.)

The bus will run through the mountain road covered with snow piled up about 20 meters high (almost 66 ft high) on both sides. You will enjoy a breath-taking view of Mt. Oyama, the highest mountain in the Alpine Route.

A section of the snow corridor around Murodo Terminal is open to pedestrians, you will have some free time to walk around.

Arrive at GRANDVIRIO HOTEL UNAZUKI ONSEN for 2 nights stay.

### **Friday, May 16<sup>th</sup> Unazuki Onsen – Kurobe – Namerikawa - Unazuki**

6:30a.m.(starts)

Buffet breakfast at the hotel.

9:00a.m.

Bus departs for KUROBE and

9:20a.m.

We will take KUROBE GORGE TROLLEY TRAIN that runs along the Kurobe River from Unazuki Station to Keyakidaira Station in Kurobe City.

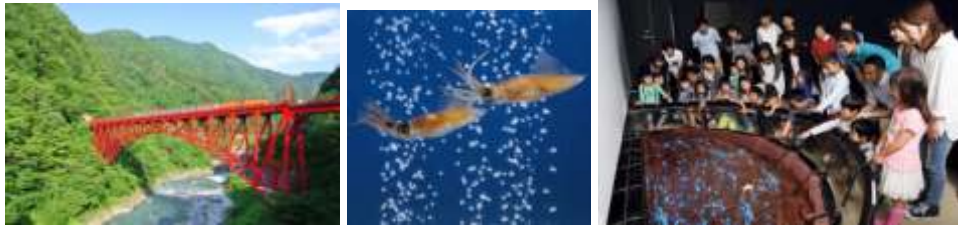
11:15a.m.

Proceed to NAMERIKAWA (Toyama). The sea of Namerikawa attracts schools of firefly squid each year from spring to early summer. HOTARU IKA, Firefly squid was designated as a representative fish of Toyama Prefecture in 1996, one of Toyama's Great Treasures.

HOTARU IKA MUSEUM is the only one of its kind in the world.

Until late May, the museum offers a Firefly “show”, in their special water tank, a net is pulled to reveal living, shining Firefly squid. There is also a tank where sea water from 333 meters (1000 feet) deep is pumped up, and visitors can directly touch the Firefly Squid.

There are no Hotaru Ika in long term captivity. Once these squid surface, they only live for about a day. In fact, the squids at the museum are brought in daily before dawn straight from the off-shore fishing nets. The museum invites you to take a journey to the sea floor guided by this mysterious light.



Lunch at your own expense at NAMERIKAWA SHOPPING MALL “YELL”, a local shopping mall with SOBA CAFÉ “TSURUYA” and 100 YEN SHOP “POPIA”.

4:00p.m. Return back to GRANDVIRIO HOTEL UNAZUKI ONSEN. Enjoy onsen before dinner.  
6:00p.m. Buffet Dinner with shabu shabu included at the hotel. ( B, D )

### **Saturday, May 17<sup>th</sup> Unazuki Onsen – Gokayama – Takayama**

6:30a.m.(starts) Buffet breakfast at the hotel. Check-out of the hotel.

9:00a.m. Bus departs for TAKAYAMA via AINOKURA GOKAYAMAVILLAGE, this village is registered as one of Japan’s UNESCO World Heritage sites. A historical landscape of GOKAYAMA and its original 20 well preserved Gasho-zukuri (thatched roof houses).



Lunch Teishoku at MICHINO EKI SHIRAKAWAGO and some shopping time.

After lunch, walk over to GASSHO MUSEUM, get to know everything there is to know about Gassho-Zukuri. A relocated genuine replica of the "Gassho-zukuri" styled building and understand more of the construction process by seeing this exhibition.

4:00p.m. Check-in at HOTEL ASSOCIA TAKAYAMA RESORT for 2 nights stay, western style onsen hotel with fabulous onsen on the 5<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> Floor.

After check-in, some free time to relax and enjoy the onsen before dinner.

5:30p.m. Buffet dinner at the hotel. ( B, L, D )

### **Sunday, May 18<sup>th</sup> Takayama**

7:00a.m.(starts) Buffet breakfast at the hotel.

9:00a.m. Tour of TAKAYAMA.

9:15a.m. First stop, MIYAGAWA MORNING MARKET, along the Miyagawa River. Open stalls selling local crafts, snacks and farm products such as vegetables, pickles and flowers.

SANNOMACHI STREET, the most retro spot in Takayama. This area is also known as "Little Kyoto" because of the preservation of the town construction from the Edo period.

Along the way is a stop at one of SAKE BREWERY and lunch on your own.

1:30-2:30p.m. HIDA TAKAYAMA MATSURI no MORI located outside of Takayama City.

The main exhibition space has a number of magnificent, life-sized replica floats are displayed, offering visitors a close view at their elaborate designs, decorations and karakuri dolls. Karakuri dolls are marionettes which are a key feature in the Takayama Festival. Also have displays of several huge taiko drums, said to be the biggest drums in the world.



3:00p.m. Return back to the hotel.

5:30p.m. Buffet dinner at the hotel. ( B, D )



**Monday, May 19<sup>th</sup>****Takayama – Seki – Gifu**

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- 7:00a.m.(starts) Buffet breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast check-out of the hotel.  
 9:00a.m. Bus departs for GIFU with one stop in SEKI.  
 10:30a.m. A visit to SEKI KNIFE MUSEUM in Seki City, Gifu. It has over 700 years of blade and cutlery making history and even today is said to be among the world's top three cutlery producers.  
 12:15-2:00p.m. Free shopping and lunch time at AEON MALL SEKI.  
 2:30p.m. Last stop, NAGARA RIVER UKAI MUSEUM, a museum with information about "UKAI" cormorant fishing on the Nagara River" which is the major tradition and culture to represent Gifu City.  
 3:45p.m. Arrive at MIYAKO HOTEL GIFU NAGARAGAWA for 1 night stay.  
 5:30-6:45p.m. Buffet dinner at the hotel.

**Seki Knife Showroom****Ukai Museum****Night Ukai Fishing**

- 7:00-8:45p.m. After dinner, shuttle bus to the boat pier, this evening, you will be seeing the famous "UKAI" viewing from the boat. Cormorant fishing has about 1,300 years of history and has traditionally been protected by both local and national authorities. It is said that the Sengoku ("Warring States Period") general ODA Nobunaga took the Ukai fishermen under his official patronage and created the official position of *usho* (Cormorant Fishing Master). The cormorants are tethered by rings around the neck so that they don't swallow the fish and the birds are released in to the river in search of Japanese trout from long, covered wooden fishing boats with braziers out front to attract the fish.  
 9:00p.m. Return back to MIYAKO HOTEL GIFU NAGARAGAWA. **(B, D)**

**Tuesday, May 20<sup>th</sup>****Gifu – Nagoya**

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- 7:00a.m.(starts) Buffet breakfast at the hotel.  
 9:00a.m. Bus departs for NAGOYA.  
 10:15-11:30a.m. SCMagLEV (Superconducting Magnetically Levitated Vehicle) and RAILWAY MUSEUM of Central Japan Railways (JR Central). The museum seeks to educate visitors on the advances in high speed rail in Japan and displays a number of actual trains, including historic steam locomotives, world record setting experimental shinkansen (bullet train) and the latest magnetic levitating trains (maglev). Many of them can be enter or view.  
 12:00-1:30p.m. Lunch & shopping time at AEON MALL OODAKA.  
 2:15-3:30p.m. Last stop, EBI SENBEI no SATO (Prawn Cracker Village), one of the best selling souvenir from AICHI PREFECTURE.

**Railway Museum****Ebi Senbei no Sato Factory**

 The rest of the day is at your leisure.

**Wednesday, May 21<sup>st</sup>****Nagoya – Honolulu**

Completed in 1615, the Hommaru Palace served as the official residence and administrative offices of the Owari Tokugawa clan. Along with the tower keeps, the Hommaru Palace was among the first castle structures to be designated a National Treasure, however, it was destroyed in the wartime air raids of 1945. Using existing Edo period (1603-1868) architectural plans and other historical resources, the palace was authentically rebuilt in 2018, returning it to its former glory.  
 Pass by TOKONAME STATION to see the 39 ceramic lucky cats along the street.  
 Last stop, AEON MALL TOKONAME for lunch and last minute shopping. The largest Maneki Neko (Lucky Cat) in the world is displayed inside Aeon Mall at the Tokoname Restaurant Street.

4:45p.m. Bus departs for NAGOYA CHUBU CENTRAIR AIRPORT.  
 6:15p.m. Arrive NAGOYA CHUBU CENTRAIR AIRPORT.
