- 8:45a.m. Please check-in at Japan Airlines, HONOLULU INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, Lobby #5.
After check-in, you may want to head straight to the TSA line, after TSA some free time.
- 11:50a.m. Depart Honolulu on Japan Airlines Flt.#073 bound for Tokyo/ Haneda, on their 787 “Dreamliner”.

Buffet dinner at RILASSA inside TOKYO DOME HOTEL. During the month of October & November, it's “HOKKAIDO FAIR” with Salmon, Ikura, Crab, Scallop (1piece per person), TOKACHI MILK RAMEN, HOKKAIDO SOFT ICE CREAM, & SOFT DRINKS are included.
After dinner, walk around TOKYO DOME to see their WINTER ILLUMINATIONS.

2:30p.m. Arrive at Ueno's Ameyoko Market a street along the Yamanote Train Line Tracks between Okachimachi and Ueno stations. NIKI no KASHI maybe one of Ameyoko's most famous vendors. They have been in business since 1947, a large discount shop for sweets, senbei(rice crackers) and assorted Kit Kat chocolate. MARUYASU, sells smoked scallops, ika (cuttlefish), tiramisu chocolate.

They also give special discount to HAWAII GROUPS

5:30p.m. Arrive back to Sunshine City Prince Hotel. The rest of the day is at your leisure. (B)

****Prepare an overnigher for 1 night stay in Hakone, the rest of your luggage will be on a truck to Grand Nikko until we check-in on 11/16****

Wednesday, Nov 15 Tokyo – Hakone for overnight stay

Breakfast at the hotel.

8:00a.m. Bus departs for LAKE KAWAGUCHI and HAKONE.

12:00-1:30p.m. Upon arrival at KAWAGUCHI MOMIJI MATSURI(Festival), some free time to go holo holo around Fuji Kawaguchiko Autumn Leaves Festival is held at Lake Kawaguchi with the amazing view of Mt Fuji and gorgeous autumn leaves!

1:45p.m. Take the KAWAGUCHIKO FUJI ROPEWAY.

The ropeway that runs in 3 minutes to the summit of Mt. Tenjo = Mt. Kachikachi, and from the observation deck at an altitude of 1,075 meters, you can see Mt. Fuji and the whole view of Lake Kawaguchiko with a panoramic view of 360 degrees,



4:30p.m. Arrive at HAKONE SENGOKUHARA PRINCE HOTEL for 1 night stay located in a beautiful forest in Sengokuhara.

6:00-8:00p.m. Dinner at the hotel.

After dinner, relax in the open-air and indoor onsen baths. You will find quality natural hot water, smooth and gentle to the skin. (B , D)

Thursday, Nov 16 Hakone – Oshino Village – Tokyo (Odaiba)

Breakfast at the hotel.

Check-out of the hotel.

8:30a.m. Bus departs for OWAKUDANI VALLEY. Some shopping time in Owakudani, "Kuro-tamago (black egg)", which is said to increase your life by seven years if you eat one, a specialty item

that can only be purchased here in Owakudani. It is boiled carefully in a hot spring pond, steamed and deliciously finished boiled egg with a special black shell.

10:00a.m.

Take HAKONE ROPEWAY from Owakudani to Togendai. It is the perfect place for enjoying Hakone's scenic view. On a clear day, majestic Mount Fuji is visible, and the steam rising from the volcanic "Jigokudani" at Owakudani down below gives the trip an added thrill.

10:20a.m.

Arrive at Togendai Ropeway Station.

10:35a.m.

Take PIRATE BOAT CRUISE on Lake Ashi, enjoy the serene natural beauty of the crater. You can see the picturesque sight of Hakone such as the glimmering surface of Lake Ashi, the highest mountain in Japan, Mt. Fuji, and the red torii (gate) floating above the lake all at one glance.

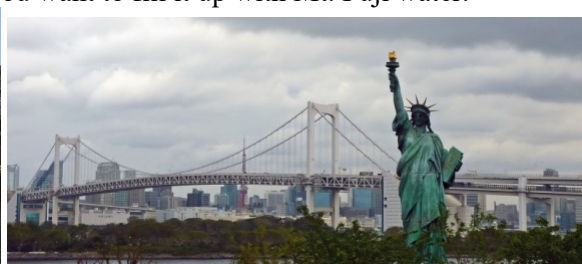
11:30a.m.

Lunch will be at HAKONE SEKISHO RESTAURANT (Basement 1); 1st floor gift shop selling local souvenirs.

After lunch, bus departs for OSHINO a small village in the Mt. Fuji area.

OSHINO HAKKAI, 8 springs of Mt. Fuji. The name was given to the 8 ponds filled with melted snow water that has taken more than 800 years to filter through the underground layer of Mt. Fuji. The water of Oshino Hakkai is ranked among the best quality water of Japan.

So bring an empty water container if you want to fill it up with Mt. Fuji water.

TOKYO TRICK MUSEUM, this museum will make you feel as though you've traveled through time to the Edo era. How would you like to take wondrous pictures in the Edo streets?

At the TOKYO TRICK ART MUSEUM, the classics gallery also contains a collection of popular works, so you can enjoy works ranging from old to brand new trick art. (admission: 1000Yen per person, open from 11:00am- 8:00pm)

TAKOYAKI MUSEUM is a collection of authentic, specially-selected Osaka shops that Osaka natives love. Shops selling takoyaki cookers and souvenirs can also be found in the museum.

Bursting with the flavor of octopus, takoyaki is Osaka "soul food" at its finest.

Pass by the illumination at Roppongi Keyakizaka Street, one of the most popular spots to visit in Tokyo during winter .

7:00p.m. Return back to GRAND NIKKO TOKYO DAIBA HOTEL. (B)
