10:30a.m. Depart on a chartered bus to SHIBAMATA TAISHAKUTEN and ASAKUSA.

11:30a.m. Arrive at Shibamata, the town sees few foreign tourists but is widely recognized by older Japanese as the hometown of Tora-san, the protagonist of a highly popular movie series, *Otoko wa Tsurai Yo* ("It is tough being a man") which was filmed from 1969 to 1995. Shibamata is lined by many shops and restaurants that sell local specialties such as dango, kuzu mocha, unagi, tsukudani, and senbei. Some of the shops boast long histories and still maintain their traditional exterior designs, adding to the ambience of the street.

12:00p.m. Arrive Atami. Leisure time to stroll around the Atami Station and lunch on your own.

- Lusca Atami is a shopping center located in a building directly connected to JR Atami Station. There are more than 20 stores in Lusca Atami with CAN-DO 100 yen shop, WELCIA Drug Store, stores selling Atami's local specialties and lunch boxes, as well as restaurants selling ramen, sushi, traditional Japanese food and pasta, you can have a great time shopping and dining.
 - In front of Atami Station, there's two shopping districts, they are Nakamise shopping arcade and Heiwa shopping arcade, both well long-established shops founded in the 60s and 70s. Unlike shopping malls, many smaller shops, restaurants, cafes, sushi shops and dried food stores and of course souvenirs from Izu Peninsula can be found.
 - There is a foot bath place in front of Atami Station called "General Ieyasu's spring" using the natural hot spring of Atami.
- 3:00p.m. Depart Atami for HAKONE to HAKONE HIGHLAND HOTEL, former residence of a baron, quietly nestled in a beautiful forest in Sengokuhara.
- 4:30p.m. Arrive at HAKONE HIGHLAND HOTEL for 1 night stay.
- 6:00-8:00p.m. Dinner at "La Forêt" French restaurant at the hotel.
- After dinner, relax in the open-air and indoor onsen baths. You will find quality natural hot water, smooth and gentle to the skin. In addition to the jacuzzi, which is great for massaging and body relaxation. (B , D)

Monday, Nov 15 Hakone – Oshino Village – Tokyo (Odaiba)

Breakfast (set menu) at the hotel.

Check-out of the hotel.

8:45a.m

Bus departs for OWAKUDANI VALLEY. Some shopping time in Owakudani, “Kuro-tamago (black egg)”, which is said to increase your life by seven years if you eat one, a specialty item that can only be purchased here in Owakudani. It is boiled carefully in a hot spring pond, steamed and deliciously finished boiled egg with a special black shell.

10:00a.m.

Take HAKONE ROPEWAY from Owakudani to Togendai. It is the perfect place for enjoying Hakone's scenic view. On a clear day, majestic Mount Fuji is visible, and the steam rising from the volcanic "Jigokudani" at Owakudani down below gives the trip an added thrill.

10:20a.m.

Arrive at Togendai Ropeway Station.

10:35a.m.

Take PIRATE BOAT CRUISE on Lake Ashi, enjoy the serene natural beauty of the crater. You can see the picturesque sight of Hakone such as the glimmering surface of Lake Ashi, the highest mountain in Japan, Mt. Fuji, and the red torii (gate) floating above the lake all at one glance.

11:30a.m.

Lunch will be at HAKONE SEKISHO RESTAURANT (Basement 1); 1st floor gift shop selling local souvenirs.

After lunch, bus departs for OSHINO a small village in the Mt. Fuji area.

OSHINO HAKKAI, 8 springs of Mt. Fuji. The name was given to the 8 ponds filled with melted snow water that has taken more than 800 years to filter through the underground layer of Mt. Fuji. The water of Oshino Hakkai is ranked among the best quality water of Japan.

So bring an empty water container if you want to fill it up with Mt. Fuji water.

Tuesday, Nov 16 Odaiba/ Tokyo (free day)

Buffet breakfast at hotel.

The rest of the day is at your leisure. (B)

You can walk to DECKS TOKYO BEACH open from 11:00a.m. next to AQUA CITY DAIBA. DECKS has a 100Yen “DAISO” (located on the 4th Floor), Fast Foods like McDonald & Yoshinoya.

MOMI & TOY'S CREPERIE (known for their crepes and Tapioca Bubble drinks)

TOKYO TRICK MUSEUM, this museum will make you feel as though you've traveled through time to the Edo era. How would you like to take wondrous pictures in the Edo streets?

At the TOKYO TRICK ART MUSEUM, the classics gallery also contains a collection of popular works, so you can enjoy works ranging from old to brand new trick art. (admission: 1000Yen per person, open from 11:00am- 8:00pm)

TAKOYAKI MUSEUM is a collection of authentic, specially-selected Osaka shops that Osaka natives love. Shops selling takoyaki cookers and souvenirs can also be found in the museum.
