Queenstown – Milford Sound

7:00a.m. (starts) Breakfast at the hotel.

9:15a.m. We will depart for our tour to MILFORD SOUND. The road to Milford Sound, which is one of the world's finest alpine drives. The scenery changes dramatically from the tussock covered grasslands to glacier hewn valleys as you enter the Eglinton Valley and travel through the breath taking man-made Homer Tunnel to reach Milford Sound.

On arrival in Milford Sound enjoy a scenic cruise on this world-famous fiord, dominated by Mitre Peak and the cascading Bowen falls. The vessel provides excellent viewing opportunities and plenty of time to enjoy the waterfalls, rain forest, mountains and wildlife.

We will be taking the Milford Mariner from the Milford Visitor Terminal to cruise the the Milford Sound area to the Tasman Sea.

We will be able to enjoy a 3-course buffet dinner.

Depart GREYMOUTH on a scenic train ride on the TRANZ-ALPINE TRAIN for CHRISTCHURCH. The Tranz-Alpine Train is one of the world's great train journeys covering 223

kilometers (139 miles) one-way . Open-air viewing platform: At one end of the train is a large open-air viewing platform, ideal for seeing and photographing the scenery, with no glass in between you and it. **Cafe-bar:** In the centre of the train is a counter selling tea, coffee, wine, beer, spirits, snacks & light microwaveable meals at reasonable prices. I can recommend a cream tea in the afternoon, and a glass of Montana Sauvignon Blanc! You take your food & drink back to your seat. **Bring cash if possible as cards are sometimes not accepted if the credit card machine is out of cellphone range.**

6:31p.m. Arrive at CHRISTCHURCH, the largest city in South Island of New Zealand. Our driver will be waiting for us at the train station.
Check-in at DISTINCTION CHRISTCHURCH HOTEL for 2 nights stay. After check-in, evening is at your leisure. (B)

Oct 30th, Thursday **Christchurch**

6:30a.m. (starts) Breakfast at the hotel.
9:30a.m. Depart for our Half day CHRISTCHURCH CITY TOUR.
10:00a.m. Our first stop will be at the INTERNATIONAL ANTARCTIC CENTER, one of New Zealand's best tourist attraction. Experience amazing Antarctica without leaving Christchurch, among other attractions, there is an Antarctic snow storm room, an audiovisual display, and little blue penguins at the NZ Penguin Encounter.



11:45a.m. Punting on the Avon River.
Then a leisure walk to MONA VALE GARDENS.
MONA VALE, with its homestead formerly known as **Karewa**, a public park in the Christchurch suburb of Fendalton. The homestead and gate house are both listed as heritage buildings with Heritage New Zealand (NZHPT). The fernery and the rose garden, and pavilion with the setting of the park along the Avon River, add to the attractiveness of the property.
BRIDGE of REMEMBRANCE is one of two main war memorials in Christchurch, New Zealand. It is dedicated to those who died in World War I.
If time permits, we will drive by CATHEDRAL SQUARE, CANTERBURY MUSEUM, HAGLEY PARK, VICTORIA SQUARE, NEW REGENT STREET, and CHRISTCHURCH TRANSITIONAL CATHEDRAL (the "CARDBOARD CATHEDRAL").

1:30p.m. Tour concludes at the hotel. The rest of day is at your leisure. (B)

Oct 31st, Friday **Christchurch - Rotorua**

6:30a.m. (starts) Breakfast at the hotel.
8:00a.m. Check-out of the hotel.
8:30a.m. Transfer to CHRISTCHURCH AIRPORT.
9:00a.m. Arrive CHRISTCHURCH AIRPORT, upon arrival, check-in at AIR NEW ZEALAND.
After check-in, you will have some time to have a coffee or grab a snack.
10:45a.m. Depart on AIR NEW ZEALAND FLT. #5782 bound for ROTORUA, the "thermal city" which is known for the Maori history and unique ongoing thermal activity including bubbling mud pools, geysers and steam vent.
12:30p.m. Arrival at ROTORUA AIRPORT. You will need to pickup your luggage.
Transfer to your hotel, NOVOTEL ROTORUA LAKESIDE for 3 nights stay.



- 5:25p.m. Recommended to bring warm jacket to the Maori Dinner Show.
Transfer to TE PA TU, New Zealand's most award winning cultural attraction.
- 6:00p.m. Evening MAORI DINNER SHOW include:
- Traditional welcoming ceremony
 - Enter Forest, welcome beverage, indigenous canape menu, interactive activities, cultural performance
 - View the hangi meal being lifted
 - Feasting on a traditional hangi buffet dinner and NZ desserts
 - Water, tea, coffee, kawakawa tea (Maori native plant) included

Nov 1st, Saturday

Rotorua

- 6:30a.m. (starts) Breakfast at hotel.
- 10:15a.m. Depart for a tour of Rotorua.
AGRODOME, for over 40 years, visitors from all over the globe have come to see the world-famous Farm Show – starring a cast of talented animal. Sheep are not just the stars of the show, remarkable farm dogs will amaze you, as they demonstrate their ability to respond to commands and keep those sheep (and ducks) in line!
Transfer to SKYLINE GONDOLA, buffet lunch at the STRATOSPHERE RESTAURANT.
Those who would like to luge may do so.
TE PUIA MAORI VILLAGE, you will encounter bubbling mud, pools of boiling water still use for cooking, and stunning geysers. In an authentic Hangi style make your own meal from a selection of raw foods including:
chicken, corn, pumpkin, potato, cabbage, and gourmet bread stuffing. Once you have placed your favorite delicacies inside the Hangi basket, you are ready to head to Nga Wha Puapua, the constantly active steam vent opening used to cook your food the authentic way.
The Pōhutu Geyser is the star of the show. Pōhutu is the largest active geyser in the southern hemisphere. She erupts once or twice every hour and sometimes reaches heights of 30 meters

6:30a.m. (starts) Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out of the hotel

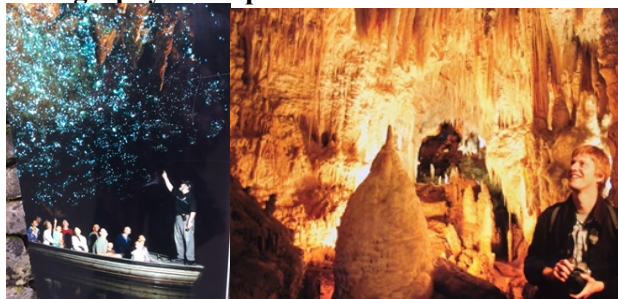
9:00a.m. Depart Rotorua for WAITOMO via Mamaku Ranges and tour the famous WAITOMO GLOW-WORM CAVES.
